 - Such as web work, social media, background IT work, etc







Society:

- Life Membership Award Certificates and cards available from the OHA Supplies Coordinator.
- Dues must still be paid by the society for the member so recognized.
- Society President's Award Available online and must be inscribed by the Society.

District:

- District Appreciation Award Template available to District Director's on GardenOntario website.
- Certificate must be inscribed by the District.
- District Service Award Nominations must be sent to and received by the District Director or designate no later than January 20th.
- The District Director, not designate, must submit the winning recipient to the OHA Awards Coordinator on or before February 15th with the date of presentation included.
- Award will be shipped directly to the District Director.

OHA Grants Program



- Seedy Saturday/Sunday Grants Up to 4 grants of up to \$250 each.
 Application forms are due for this grant only by November 15th for an event the following year. This grant has been opened up for all Societies/Clubs to be able to apply, even if you held an event previously. Please check out the new form on the GardenOntario website.
- Special Project/Environmental Grant Up to 4 grants of up to \$1000 each
- Community Garden Grant Up to 3 grants of up to \$500 each
- Pollinator Garden Grant Up to 10 grants of up to \$200 each









OHA Grants Program

- Tree Grants Up to 20 grants of up to \$300.00 each
- Technical Advancement Grants Up to 6 grants of up to \$250.00 each
- These 2 grants work on a first come, first served basis starting January 1st up to Feb 28th each year.
 - Letters of approval will be sent out as soon as applications are received if all paperwork is in order. Once the grant maximum has been reached, the application process will be closed. No applications will be accepted before January 1st.
- Youth Grants Up to 50 grants of up to \$75.00 each. Although these grants work on a first come, first served basis, they are accepted throughout the year.

- Please be sure to read through the required criteria for each award and grant that you are thinking of applying for or nominating someone for.
- Please follow all deadlines as marked, there will be no exceptions.
- Please ensure all required paperwork is included in your application when submitting it such as insurance certificate, photos, plant list, etc.
- If you have not received a notice within 2 weeks that your application has been received, please contact the OHA Awards Coordinator to confirm.
- If you are applying/nominating with less than 2 weeks remaining until the deadline, please contact the OHA Awards Coordinator immediately upon submission to confirm.
