- 4. <u>Resources</u> On the GardenOntario.org website, there is so much information for Societies. General Guide for Horticulture Society/Club Officers (a printed copy is provided on the tables, but a newer version is being worked on by the OHA), Meeting Guidelines, Bus Waivers, Photo Release Forms, Supplies, Awards & Grants (which Kelly will talk to us about in more detail), Speakers Lists, Judges List and more. Society pages are free and where you can share info & events, a reminder to please keep these updated. Every Society board member should sign a Code of Conduct of Oath of Office & Confidentiality Agreement, a customizable form is provided under Resources.
- 5. <u>TPON</u> Get funding from the Ontario government. They've changed the way you access Transfer Payment Ontario (TPON). As of April 17, 2023, they have switched over from ONe-key/GO Secure ID to My Ontario Account. For more information, please refer to Creating a My Ontario Account Transfer your profile to the MyOntario account using the same email address used on your TPON account.
- 6. ONCA Ontario has updated rules for not-for-profit corporations under the Ontario Non-Profit Corporations Act (ONCA) that came into effect on October 19, 2021, with a 3-year transition period to comply. Under OMAFRA, the OHA and Horticultural Societies in Ontario are considered incorporated non-profit organizations as per the Agricultural and Horticultural organization Act. As such, every Society will need to make any necessary changes to your Constitution/By-Laws/Rules of Governance to bring them into conformity with ONCA by October 2024.
 - a. Charles Freeman, over a 20-month period, has created a guideline for the OHA, Districts and Societies on what changes we need to make to our Bylaws/Constitution/Rules of Governance to bring them into compliance with ONCA. A printed copy of his report is on the tables, one per Society. Charles has also clarified that as for the Articles of Incorporation, they are the property of the Society/Club. They are not applied for; they are simply submitted by the Society/Club with all of the other documents required to be sent to OMAFRA.
 - b. Changes made to your Bylaws/Constitution/ Rules of Governance must be approved at an annual general meeting or a special meeting of your members to come into effect.
